THREE-SEEDED MERCURY

Life Cycle: Annual

Reproduction: Seeds only

Habitat: Open woods, fields, waste places, ditches and roadsides.

Seedling I.D.

- Cotyledons are round with conspicuous veins and indented at the tip.
- First two leaves are opposite, subsequent leaves are alternate.
- Leaves are oval to slightly elongated, sparsely hairy, green to coppery-green in colour, with shallow, rounded teeth on the margins (see yellow arrow).
